7/15/2021	Designated Housing for Elderly and Disabled Families	PH	<i>Does your PHA operate all or part of its property as “designated housing”?</i> Public housing properties are defined as mixed population, general population, and designated housing. Many PHAs think they have designated housing, when in fact, there are less than 400 HUD-approved designated housing projects nationwide. This webinar addresses the differences among the three types of housing including how each type of housing impacts their tenant selection and assignment of rental units, who can reside in designated housing units, relocation requirements for those currently living in units that do not qualify as designated housing, directions for developing designated housing plans for the elderly or disabled, and the renewal requirements of HUD-approved designations.
